NOTICE OF INQUIRY RESULT



On Tuesday, 16 August 2016, Greyhound Racing South Australia Stewards inquired into the analysis of a urine sample taken from the greyhound CABOOSE, trained by Mr. Kenneth Newlyn, which had shown the presence of COBALT at the Greyhound Racing SA race meeting held at Angle Park on Thursday, 10 March 2016.

The reserve portion of the urine sample was tested and the presence of COBALT was confirmed in excess of the threshold of 100ng/mL, according to GAR 83(10).

Evidence was taken from Mr. Paul Zahra (Scientific Manager Racing Analytical Service Limited), Dr. Greg Moore (GRSA Veterinarian) and Mr. Newlyn. Trainer Mr. Neil Rawlings tendered a statement in support of Mr. Newlyn

After considering the matter and all the evidence before them, Stewards believed there was sufficient evidence to charge Mr. Newlyn with a contravention of GAR 83(2) which reads:

The owner, trainer or person in charge of a greyhound –

(a) nominated to compete in an event;

shall present the greyhound free from any prohibited substance

(3) The owner, trainer or person in charge of a greyhound presented contrary to sub-rule (2) shall be guilty of an offence.

Mr. Newlyn pleaded guilty to the charge.

Stewards adjourned to consider the matter of penalty.

The inquiry will reconvene on Monday, 22 August 2016 at 4pm at the Greyhound Racing South Australia offices, 55 Cardigan Street, Angle Park.
