## ***NOTICE OF INQUIRY***

Greyhound Racing South Australia Stewards intend to inquire into the analysis of a urine sample taken from the greyhound PONTING'S NAIL, trained by Mr. Philip Lenehan, which had shown the presence of COBALT at the Greyhound Racing SA race meeting held at Mount Gambier on Sunday, 24 April 2016.

The reserve portion of the urine sample was tested and the presence of COBALT was confirmed in excess of the threshold of 100ng/mL, according to GAR 83(10).

Mr. Lenehan is now required to attend this inquiry which will take place at the Greyhound Racing South Australia offices, 55 Cardigan Street, Angle Park on Tuesday, 27 September 2016 at 2pm, along with any witnesses which may assist the inquiry.

As a result of this inquiry, charges may be laid pursuant to GRSA Rules of Greyhound Racing.

He was further advised that if he does not attend this inquiry it may be held in his absence and charges may be laid pursuant to GRSA Rules of Greyhound Racing.
