On 11th February 2016 Mr. Michele Famiglietti was informed in person that the greyhound ARE ATE had shown the presence of AMPHETAMINE from the Out of Competition urine sample taken from the greyhound ARE ATE at his registered kennel address on Tuesday 5th January 2016, and that he would be advised of the date, time and place of an inquiry.

The reserve portion of the urine sample was tested and the presence of AMPHETAMINE was confirmed.

He is now required to attend an inquiry at the offices of Greyhound Racing South Australia Limited, 55 Cardigan Street, Angle Park on Wednesday 30th March 2016 at 10.30am, together with any witnesses that may assist for an inquiry by the Stewards into the circumstances relating to the obtaining of the positive urine sample.

As a result of this inquiry charges may be laid pursuant to GRSA Rules of Greyhound Racing.

He was further advised that if he does not attend this inquiry it may be held in his absence and charges may be laid pursuant to GRSA Rules of Greyhound Racing.
